
With a total of 10 games, 9 conference, 1 non-conference, Eagles came up with the best record in 3 years, a record of 4-5.

Playing one of the best games all season on a snow-spotted field, the Eagles came off short losing to the conference champions, the Florence Bobcats, 12-0.


For the '74 season, Chuck Fondrie was selected to the NLC All Conference Team, and Mike Brey received honorable mention.








The hard work and time devoted by the team and coach were evident on the basketball court. The Eagles played some very exciting games this year, the most memorable being a victory over Crandon on our home court.

With the support of the student body at our games you can see just how far girls sports have gone!










The Percussion section of the band always keeps the Chorus and Glee Club in beat.




