

David Anderson has been teaching Band, Mixed Chorus and Concert Choir at Northland Pines High School for twenty-five years.

Marv Heinonen joined our staff this year. He teaches Basic Business, Consumer Education and Typing One.




John Knickerbocker is also a new member of our Northland Pines staff. He teaches Basic Business and Distributive Education.

Diane Maurer teaches all the German classes. She has been a member of the NPHS staff for four years.







Kay Oleson, a new staff member this year, spends her day helping NPHS students in the IMC as head Librarian.



Jean Wollum teaches Home Economics Two and Chef classes. She has been a member of the NPHS faculty for seventeen years.




Jim Lyons has taught at Northland Pines High School for seven years. He teaches Geography, US History and Psychology.





Jack Spicuzza has been teaching at Northland Pines High School for eight years. He teaches Sociology and World History.




All The Way To State Boys . . .


