
Fashion: In And Out Of Classes

Since classrooms were always at different temperatures, students were forced to wear cool clothes for some classes and warm clothes for others. At times, who knew what to wear!





Local Happenings

During the first semester this year, NPHS was fortunate to host the first foreign exchange student. Annika Bengtsson, a senior, is from Arvika, Sweden. She learned about our culture and found many unusual things in America. The United States government is very different. "Sweden is socialistic and probably will be again this fall (1982). That means that our government owns a lot of companies and we pay tax to them, but, then, our newspapers and TV programs are not censored."

U. S. television intrigues her. In Sweden her family is able to get only two television stations. These stations are owned by the government; therefore, there are no commercials. Some shows that are popular here are shown in Sweden. MASH, Taxi, Muppet Show and, of course, Dallas can be seen.

Eating habits are different according to Annika. "Here in America, there are a lot of fast foods and sweet things. At home, we eat more fish, bread, fruit, vegetables, and potatoes."

Annika finds the school system to be unusual. "In Sweden we start school when we are 7 years old. Then we go to preparation college for 2, 3, or 4 years. Then we have university, but it's so hard to get in there and many people start to work instead."

Music in Sweden is similar to that of the United States. "We listen to the same music as young kids here do, but some music comes to Europe later than here. We have more British music and also a lot of Swedish music. My favorite band is Dag-Vag."

The day that Annika left NPHS, she turned 18. This gave her the opportunity in her country to vote and to get her driver's license, which costs \$300.00. This birthday was a happy, but sad day for Annika. For she was leaving NPHS, a place where she met people she would never forget and acquired beautiful memories. But soon she would be reunited with her family; a family she had not seen for several months.

In case of unforeseen circumstances, Jane Ulrich, as alternate, would have this opportunity.




Student Council members are chosen from each class to represent NPHS government. Mr. Rickard advised and helped with school problems.

Congratulations to everyone who participated, and especially to those who received ribbons.




